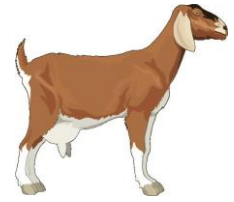
#### Countywide Rabbit Project Meeting

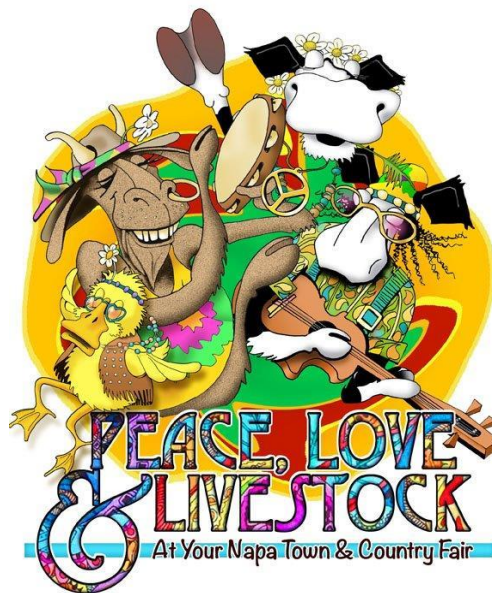


## Countywide Poultry Project Meeting
